(The current plan is being updated to include Technology as a critical need. Rather than purchasing Health books and teacher resource materials, ICHS was able to have those items donated and used \$800 to purchase the Office 2007 software.)

2009 - 2010 SCHOOL PLAN

Critical Needs:

Mathematics  
Writing

Academic Goals:

10% Reduction in Students not Passing Math CRTs  
10% Reduction in Students not Passing Writing UBSCT

Planned Steps:

Purchase of math manipulatives to facilitate learning in geometry. \$50  
Purchase of graphing calculators, scientific calculators, and calculator projector to facilitate learning in advanced math classes. \$3553  
Purchase of Aleks subscriptions for remediation/reinforcement in math. \$400  
Purchase of language arts textbooks to improve writing skills. \$1550

Measuring Progress Toward Goals:

ICHS will use scores from the math CRTs and the writing UBSCT - both pre and post plan to measure attainment of its goals.

The target to be achieved is a 10% reduction in the number of students not passing the math CRTs and the writing UBSCT.

Plans for expenditures of increased distribution:

ICHS will use any additional funding to purchase additional language arts textbooks to facilitate writing/reading instruction and learning.

The ICHS SIP includes a school-wide, testing-wide objective of a reduction in the number of students not passing CRTs and UBSCT sections by 10%.
